How to Apply

Grant proposals are accepted at any time, and we review them four times per year. Instructions, tips, and deadlines can be found at **ardc.net/apply/**. We will let you know whether or not your grant will be funded two to four months after the start of the review cycle.



ARDC has been awarding grants since 2019, and we've loved seeing their impacts ever since!

These include:

- Providing scholarships to more than 300 students, many from underrepresented groups.
- Helping amateur radio clubs engage youth in amateur radio.
- Funding projects that advance the state of the art in amateur radio.
